# WHY TO DO RESEAR(H IN ESTONIA?

- Estonian research is human scale. Every individual has the opportunity to excel. You don't have to be stuck in a lab forever.
- Thanks to the size and flexibility of Estonian institutions, there is a huge opportunity to engage in inter-disciplinary cooperation and research on any field.
- In Estonia cooperation with peers, institutions and administration is direct and supportive without layers of bureaucracy to blunt the senses.

The nominal length of doctoral studies in Estonia is 3-4 years, after which a post-graduate research degree (doktorikraad) may be conferred. A Master's qualification is required for entry to doctoral studies

### GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The following documents are usually required for an application for a PhD programme:

- A completed application form
- PhD thesis project
- Certified copies of certificates/degrees/ qualifications showing eligibility for doctoral studies
- An academic transcript(s)
- An academic CV
- A statement of purpose
- Two or three photos
- A copy of an identification document

Specific requirements depend on the requirements of the institution of higher education and on the particular course. All prospective international students should contact the university they wish to attend for additional information.

Doctoral studies in Estonia are for free. PhD students studying full time have the right to receive a monthly stipend of 383.47€. Ask more specifically about the scholarship opportunities from the university coordinators.

## SCHOLARSHIPS FOR VISITING PHD STUDENTS AT ESTONIAN UNIVERSITIES

The scholarships cover research and study visits of 1-10 months by international PhD students to Estonian universities regardless of the subject area. The stipend will cover the study allowance (383,47€ per month), travel expenses (according to the unit price), residence expenses, health insurance, mobility allowance (up to 260€ per month) and the study and research expenses of the visiting Doctoral student.

Candidates must be enrolled in a doctoral programme at a recognized educational institution in another country. For detailed information on eligibility requirements, deadlines and application, consult your university in Estonia.

The support scheme is financed by the European Social Fund under the DoRa programme. The programme is run by the Centre of Higher Education Development, Archimedes Foundation. Information can be obtained from:
